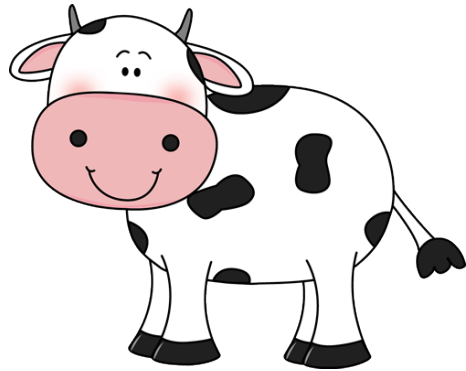




Weighing an animal



About 500 - 600 kg

A cow is quite a big animal and so we use kilograms (kg) to measure how heavy it is.



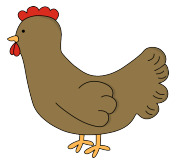
About 20 - 30 g

A mouse is a small animal and we can use grams (g) to measure how heavy it is.



About 100 mg

A bee is really small so we can use mg to measure how heavy it is.



About 2.5 - 4 kg

A hen is smaller than a cow but still big enough to use kilograms (kg) to measure how heavy it is.



About 25 - 30 g

Most frogs are small animals and we use grams to weigh them but there is a Goliath frog that can weigh over 3000 g or 3 kg.



About 20 - 30 mg

Most beetles like ladybirds are really small but the biggest, the Goliath beetle, can weigh 50,000 mg or 50 g.
